## 1. <u>Apologies</u>

Apologies were received from Cllr. B. Stokes

#### 2. Declarations of Interest

Cllr. P. Wilks declared an interest in Item 7 - Lawnmower - and will abstain from taking part.

#### 3. <u>Minutes of the previous Meeting</u>

Agreed by Members and signed by the Chairman as a true transcript.

#### 4. <u>Matters Arising from the Minutes</u>

<u>Change of Meeting Day</u> - to assist the Village Hall Committee with the hire of the hall it was agreed that the monthly meeting of the Parish Council will take place on Wednesdays as from April.

<u>Broadband</u> – It was clarified that up to £75 subsidy towards installation costs will only be available to residents having fibre to the cabinet (FTTC) high speed broadband installed once BT Openreach has carried out the necessary work; this subsidy in the main to assist those on low income. There are restrictions – only £15,000 from K.C.C. will be available to fund the subsidies and this money must be spent within twelve months. Discussions around how the installation subsidy would be administered to be carried forward.

<u>Phase 8 – Playtrail</u> – Members agreed to ask Swale Borough Council to use the contribution towards exercise equipment for adults, to be located near to the children's play area in the village park.

<u>Countrystyle Heat & Power</u> – Cllr. Wilks informed that whilst responding to K.C.C. regarding the additional information in relation to this application, an officer from the Environment

Agency had queried the white dust pollution in the village. As a result of the conversation, and as the officer was interested in following up this problem, Cllr. Wilks has asked for an article to appear on <u>www.iwadevillage.co.uk</u> asking villagers to contact the website if they experience this nuisance.

# 5. <u>Visitors/Public Time</u>

A parishioner asked if the Parish Council was aware of the proposed horse fair at Raspberry Hill. The Chairman responded that this information had only filtered through within the last couple of days and that the Parish Council will contact Swale and Kent County Councils and the Police to determine the situation.

**County Councillors** –Cllr. Whiting reported that the costings are through for moving the zigzag lines outside the school.

## 6. Finance

<u>Iwade Scouts, Cubs and Beavers</u> – a representative did not attend the meeting. The Chairman proposed that the Parish Council agree the donation of £624 in principle, to pay for the use of the hall for their meetings – expenditure agreed under S19 1976LG(MP)A: the Parish Council's power to support recreational activity.

<u>Mother and Toddlers Club</u> –members of the Group who addressed the Parish Council and requested assistance with the cost of the hire of the village hall. The Chairman proposed and Cllr. Wilks seconded that a donation of £312 be granted - expenditure agreed under S19 1976LG(MP)A: the Parish Council's power to support recreational activity

<u>CiLK request for donation</u> – Members were unable to agree to a request for a donation.

<u>Lawn Mower</u> – Clerk advised that she had received an offer of £250 for this equipment. Acceptance was proposed by the Chairman and seconded by Cllr. D. White – agreed.
