1. Welcome and Apologies

In the absence of the Chair and Vice-Chair, Cllr. Plum chaired the meeting and welcomed everyone; apologies received from Parish Cllrs. Gale, Hunt and Hyde.

3. Minutes of the Previous Meeting

Proposed by Cllr. Langham and seconded by Cllr. Cheeseman, the Minutes of the Planning Committee meeting held on the 29th March 2017 were agreed and signed as a true transcript.

4. Visitors/Public Time

1. **Visitors** – A resident raised the issue of the removal of the telephone kiosk by BT to whom she has raised an objection.

Another resident queried whether areas between build outs should be used for parking; the Community Warden thought there were no restrictions on this; however, they are not parking bays. Clerk to ask the PCSO to look into the areas in School Lane.
