### MINUTES OF THE MONTHLY PARISH COUNCIL MEETING

## Held on Wednesday 10 April 2019

### 1. Welcome and Apologies

In the absence of Cllr. Cheeseman, Cllr. Clark chaired the meeting. He welcomed everyone; apologies received from Parish Cllrs. Cheeseman, Horner and Dicker and the PCSO.

### 2. Declarations of Interest and Dispensations

Dispensations are in place for Members relating to The Barn and Iwade School.

### 3. Minutes of the Previous Meeting

Proposed by Cllr. Mills and seconded by Cllr. Dollimore, the Minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on the 13 March 2019 were agreed and signed as a true transcript.

## 4. Visitors/Public Time

- 1. **Visitors** Representatives from Gilling Planning attended the meeting to outline the Care Home application (6.3 below). This already has outline approval and the current application is for reserved matters. They mentioned that they had made provision for 25 car parking spaces, for visitors and staff; Councillors raised their concern that this would be insufficient.
- 2. County and Borough Councillors County Cllr. Whiting advised that the police are looking into reports of speeding in Stangate Drive after a resident raised concerns with him. There has been a lot of activity regarding alleged asbestos contamination at a site in Peach Blossom Drive; raised with Swale and the Environment Agency on behalf of residents. The MP and Cllr Dewar-Whalley have also raised it with Swale and the Health and Safety Executive. Cllr. Whiting is not aware of any enforcement action to date. He will keep pressing for clarification on whether there is a public health issue. KCC has launch a page to gather feedback on bus services. This will provide a greater understanding of what types of problems bus users experience and spot trends about the areas or on which services they arise. The information will be used to inform the conversations that KCC Public Transport have with bus operators through our Quality Bus Partnerships, or more generally to help improve things for bus users. KCC is encouraging people to use the form to let them know about their experience of using buses and the quality of service provided. - 3. **Community Warden/PCSO** Community Warden written report: Reported fly tipping incidents in Old Ferry Road, Raspberry Hill Lane, Sheerstone and Sheppey Way to Swale Borough Council. Checked on School gate. Reported blocked drain and day burner to KCC. Investigated a reported abandoned vehicle. Dealt with parking issues in The Street.

### 5. Matters Arising from the Minutes

1. **Dark Nights = Double the Dog Poo** – Dog Warden reports there appears to be a reduction in faeces.

- 2. **Speeding and Speed Watch** In-hand, some Councillors have already taken up training.
- 3. **Street Lighting Grovehurst Road (footpath and Vegetation)** Highways Steward is looking into the footpath surface and will get vegetation cut back.
- 4. **Vandalism Bus Shelter** Things are quiet at present. Cllr. Dollimore will still look into antivandalism paint for the roofs. *Action: Cllr. Dollimore*
- 5. **Bollards, The Street** –Clerk to arrange a site meeting; bring back to next meeting. <u>Action: Clerk</u>

# 6. Planning

- 1. **19/500901/FULL:** Culnells Farm School Lane Iwade Kent: Erection of a timber summerhouse no objections.
- 2. **19/501360/FULL**: Erection of a first floor side extension: 3 Springvale Iwade Kent ME9 8RY no objections.
- 3. 19/501160/REM: Reserved Matters relating to layout, scale and appearance of the proposed building and the landscaping of the site pursuant to outline application 16/505299/OUT for construction of a 60 bed care home (within Class C2): Coleshall Farm Ferry Road Iwade Kent ME9 8QY Agreed to respond: The Parish Council has no objections to the application. However, Councillors have concerns regarding parking. We understand there are 25 spaces but taking into account staff and visitors, we can foresee cars parked on the access road and Sheppey Way. Application 18/506677/HYBRID is currently under consideration by Swale and the entrance to this development will be in close proximity to the care home. The Parish Council feels that in light of the existing traffic calming and the two new entrances this area should be looked at with a view to redesigning the highway to avoid future issues.
