# MINUTES OF THE MONTHLY PARISH COUNCIL MEETING

## 1. <u>Welcome and Apologies</u>

The Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting; apologies received from Parish Cllrs. Mitchell, Cheeseman, Clark, Mills, Langham and Dicker, Nick Mayatt, Community Warden and County Cllr. M. Whiting.

#### 2. <u>Declarations of Interest and Dispensations</u>

Dispensations are in place for Members relating to The Barn and Iwade School.

#### 3. <u>Minutes of the Previous Meeting</u>

Proposed by Cllr. Dollimore and seconded by Cllr. Hyde, the Minutes of the Parish meeting held on the 12 September 2018 were agreed and signed as a true transcript.

#### 4. <u>Visitors/Public Time</u>

- 1. **Visitors** A resident raised the issue of maintenance of the orchards to the rear of Woodpecker Park; Clerk to put him in touch with the relevant Officer at Swale Borough Council. <u>Action: Clerk</u>
- 2. **County and Borough Councillors** County Cllr. Whiting reported via letter, has dealt with a number of individuals on school matters and highways issues.
- 3. **Community Warden/PCSO** Community Warden Fly-tipping in Old Ferry Road reported to Swale Council. School and ASB parking in areas surrounding the school, has visited the areas highlighted by residents unfortunately he has not seen anything untoward but will be linking up with the new PCSO in the near future to keep an eye on the situation.

The Chair stated that it appears from a social media post a resident believes the Parish Council doesn't care about fly-tipping, apart from reporting it to the Borough Council, PCSO or Community Warden, sadly there is very little it can do.

  - 3. Offer to purchase land, side of access to Coleshall Farm sum requested to purchase the strip of land containing the Poplar Trees leading up to Coleshall Farm is £5000; Members agreed not to go ahead with this.
